Dear WP3-Team,

Hope all is well.

We are pleased to share with you the minutes of our previous WP3-board meeting available here on the Only Office: https://projects.put.poznan.pl/Products/Projects/TMDocs.aspx?prjID=9#1429. Thank you again for your participation to this meeting. All your feedbacks have been well noted and taken in a very constructive manner. In fact, it has allowed us to develop our thinking even further.

We take this opportunity to get back to you regarding the EUNICE WEEKS since we realised that during our last meeting there was a partial agreement on the new concepts introduced and more specifically on the EUNICE DAY part: invited lectures on EU matters and local cultural events.


As you are aware, we agreed to spread the EUNICE DAY events (lectures and cultural events) over the entire academic year. However, after studying the issue in depth, we realised that what we had agreed on seems a bit theoretical and difficult to implement it for the following reasons:

- The unavailability of students in some universities (UVA, UC, UPHF) in April;
- The impossibility for UVA to take part in the EUNICE DAYS in April, May and June;
- The very short time frame to implement the first events conference and cultural events in April, May;
- The last-minute communication that will follow (and as a result a low level of participation).

To overcome the above challenges, we believe that our approach should be revised. This is why we would like to make a **new adjusted proposal of the EUNICE DAY** that takes into account our previous agreement while addressing all constraints.

As illustrated in the below calendar, we suggest to postpone the EUNICE DAY to next autumn. Thus, the physical sport tournament(s) would remain from 24-28 October and the month of November would be dedicated to the EUNICE DAY (lectures and cultural events).

One invited lecture would be organised each Tuesday and one cultural event each Thursday. This will allow each university to host one event according to their possibilities and wishes. E.g.:



on Tuesday 8^{th} Nov: one invited lecture on EU Matters; on Thursday 10^{th} Nov: one cultural event, on Tuesday 15^{th} Nov: one lecture, and so on.

Since the **format of the invited lecture** & debate (split into two) was not as popular as expected among the WP3 team, we would like to leave this matter **open** and give the possibility to each university to choose the format and implement the one they find most appropriate and effective. However, we would like to stress that the debate should remain <u>accessible to all</u> students. Therefore, a good preparation beforehand seems essential. Please take this into account during your preparation.

We are convinced that this EUNICE DAY adjusted proposal would work better for each partner for the following reasons:

- November seems to be a more favourable time for students to participate in such initiatives (compared to April, may, June);
- This will allow UVA to take part in all activities;
- A better preparation time to organise those events;
- A better communication plan could be implemented (and as an expected result a better participation rate);
- This will approach requires less work in each of the universities (only one event to host), while still meeting the objectives of the action

Please let us know if this adjusted proposal could work for you? And **if you agree with the proposal** a) Yes b) No. If yes, please send us your **three preferred slots** (3 prioritised choice) when your university would be able to host an event: either an invited lecture (on 8,15,22 Nov) or a cultural event (10,17,24 Nov). Your choices should include both types of events.

In addition, we would like to share with you some feedback regarding the **EUNICE WEEK** part: the physical sport tournament(s) organised at Poznan University next October 2022.

In general, we all agreed on the sport tournament concept: football tournament and chess finals. But, one question remained unanswered: How many football tournaments should we consider? Option a) one tournament (mixed teams) b) two tournaments: male and female. Please send us your opinion on this.

We also looked in more detail at the **ERAMUS** + **funding opportunities dedicated to sport events** as suggested by Liliana. This seems very adequate to finance our EUNICE tournament. The
deadline to send applications is on 23rd March 2022. Thus, we would appreciate if PUT Team could
analyse this further so that this can be discussed during our next WP3-board meeting. More

We would like to plan a WP3-board meeting at the end of this month, which should allow us to finalise our reflection on EUNICE WEEKS concepts. But, in the meantime, we would be grateful to receive your thoughts on this so that we know how to proceed further.
